



Network Box


With Avision's state-of-the-art Network Box, you can upgrade your Avision USB scanner to a wireless (Wi-Fi) or wired device to let other computers or mobile devices access the scanned image in the LAN.


When the Network Box APP is installed on a mobile device, you can use the mobile device to scan documents with the Avision's scanner connected to a wireless LAN. You can also specify document scan settings using the Network Box APP. The scanned images can be received directly on the mobile device.

What is best, the Avision Network Box itself can be used as an Access Point (AP) when a Wi-Fi router or hotspot is not available in your location.
